

REGULAR MEETING - March 24, 2022

A Regular Meeting of the Tech Valley Regional Technology Institute (Tech Valley High School), a joint venture of the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Albany-Schoharie-Schenectady-Saratoga Counties, 900 Watervliet-Shaker Road, Albany, New York, and the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of Rensselaer-Columbia-Greene Counties, 10 Empire State Boulevard, Castleton, New York, was held on March 24, 2022 via Zoom, as directed in the Governor's Executive Order 202.1, due to the response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. by President Brooks.

APPROVAL OF SALES QUOTATION WITH AUDIO-VISUAL CORPORATION

RESOLVED: that the Tech Valley High School Operating Board hereby approves the sales quotation from Audio-Visual Corporation for a Classroom System Upgrade as per the terms provided for \$12,606.00.

In answer to a question, Dr. Amy Hawrylchak, Principal and Chief Academic Officer, TVHS, explained the system upgrade was part of approved work that had been postponed due to COVID-19. The motion passed unanimously.

It was moved by Mrs. Lenhardt and seconded by Mrs. delPrado to approve the following:

APPROVAL OF THE 2022-2023 TVHS **CALENDAR**

RESOLVED: that the Tech Valley High School Operating Board approves the 2022-2023 TVHS calendar. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Hawrylchak presented the proposed 2022-2023 TVHS budget. She explained that the increase from .6 FTE to .8 FTE for the School Social Worker and the additional Teaching Assistant position would support mental health needs. Also, a part-time cleaner would assist with COVID-19 protocols.

PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED 2022-2023 TVHS BUDGET

It was moved by Mr. Garland and seconded Mrs. delPrado to approve the following:

RESOLVED: that the Tech Valley High School Operating Board approves the Proposed Budget of \$2,736,223 for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Hawrylchak shared the results of the 9th grade enrollment lottery and noted that Ms. Shannon Tahoe, School Attorney, Capital Region BOCES, oversaw the REPORT

process. She highlighted the success of the robotics team placing second in the FIRST Robotics Competition at the MVP Arena and winning the Gracious Professionalism Award. She shared that some of the students' I-Term experiences have resulted in paid internships. Mr. Garland asked if more partners are needed for I-Term experiences. Dr. Hawrylchak acknowledged the challenges of identifying opportunities during pandemic conditions and welcomed recommendations for new partners. In answer to a question from Mrs. Lenhardt, Dr. Hawrylchak said she had not yet seen an increase in school districts sending students to TVHS.

Ms. Anita Murphy, District Superintendent, Capital Region BOCES, extended her congratulations to Dr. Gladys Cruz, District Superintendent, Questar III BOCES, on her election as President of AASA, The School Superintendents Association. Dr. Cruz offered her congratulations to TVHS staff and students for their showing at the FIRST Robotics Competition.
